"As part of our mission at Bear Givers, we host art exhibits featuring the work of children who have special needs or who are in pediatric rehabilitation as a way to empower them. Having an art show makes them feel proud and promotes their self-esteem significantly. We find that hanging their paintings alongside art pieces from professional accomplished artists and celebrities is even more impactful and brings extra magic to the event. 100% of sale proceeds goes to the children's organization we host the show for.

This particular event is for the children of the Sandy Hook community, many of whom were directly affected by the shooting tragedy and lost siblings and friends. This Art Show is called "Visions of Tomorrow" and the proceeds will go to the Sandy Hook Art Center for Kids, founded in December after the tragedy to give local children somewhere to paint and heal."
